

## **GENERAL INFORMATION**

### **HOURS**

Classes begin in January, May and September. Hours are 8:00 AM- 3:00 PM Monday thru Friday for January and May classes, and 9:00 AM-6:00 PM Monday-Thursday for the September class.

### **LENGTH OF PROGRAM**

The program is a 12-month full time program. (see school calendar for Holidays and Breaks)

### **BACKGROUND CHECK**

National Background check must be completed prior to being accepted into the program. Background Checks may be completed at the following web site. The cost is \$56. Applicants must apply at [www.certifiedbackground.com](http://www.certifiedbackground.com). The school code is GA18. Results will be posted on line and you may review the results when completed

### **ENTRANCE TESTING**

Applicants must take the Nurse Entrance Test (NET) offered at Green Country, exams taken at other programs will not be accepted.

The NET is a basic generalized exam that measures the content area of Reading, Mathematics, Science and Writing. The exam will be taken on computer in the Academic Center at GCTC and is only offered on Wednesdays by appointment. Potential candidates must arrive at 8:00 AM, those who are late will not be allowed to begin the test.

A testing fee of \$50 must be paid prior to taking the exam. This fee must be paid for each attempt. In the event that an applicant fails to meet the minimal requirements, documented remediation must be presented before the candidate is allowed to test again. There are only two attempts allowed for the exam

There are HESI study guides that may be checked out of the PN office. Prior to checking out a study guide you must pre-pay for the NET and schedule within 30 days. The study guide must be turned prior to testing. Candidates who fail to return the study guide, or fail to show up at the scheduled time will forfeit the testing fee and will not be allowed to test

## **DRUG SCREENING**

All students accepted into the Nursing program will be randomly drug tested. This will be performed prior to any scheduled clinical rotation. The cost is included in the program fees. Students who test positive will be dismissed from the program

## **ACCEPTANCE**

When an applicant has met all admission requirements and completed the application file, they will be awarded an acceptance letter and may pay a \$200 non-refundable deposit to secure their placement in the class of their choice (January, May, or September). The start date must be within one year of acceptance.

Students requesting advanced standing must make an appointment with the Director of Nursing/HCP to discuss the policy and subsequent testing

## **DEADLINE**

Deadlines for application are as follows. Please note that classes may fill prior to deadlines, so you are encouraged to complete you application packet and student file prior to these dates

December 1<sup>st</sup> for January class

April 1<sup>st</sup> for May class

August 1<sup>st</sup> for September class
